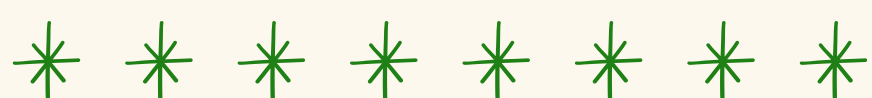
SPREAD SOME HOLIDAY CHEER!

Toys for Tots **December 1 - 17**

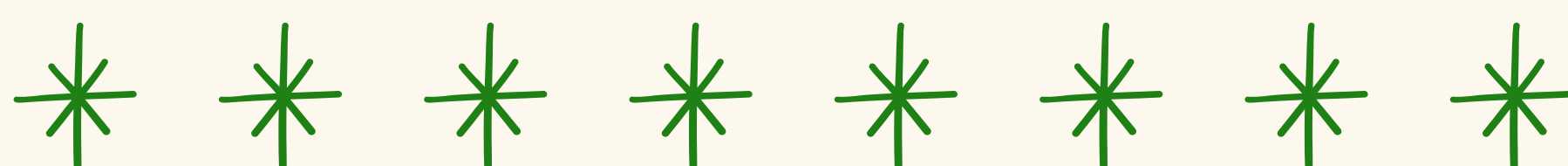
We will be collecting NEW/UNWRAPPED toys for area children! Please bring your donation to the donation box in the office by Wednesday, December 17.

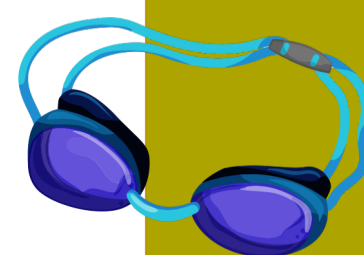
